EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING AND LEARNING

STAFF TRAINING

Teaching Staff completed DISC training on the recent SDD. DISC is a training and development tool designed to improve work productivity, teamwork, and communication. Staff completed an individual survey and then were led in a workshop to understand their own style and also learn about other people's DISC styles. We anticipate utilising the opportunity to build more effective relationships. Feedback from staff was extremely positive.



Support staff accessed professional Learning from Tanya Graham our school psychologist on Behaviour – the escalation profile and effective strategies for dealing with student behaviour. They then had a presentation from our Visiting Teacher focussing on Autism. Several of our staff made presentations about roles currently held within the school and feedback from Professional Learning that staff have undertaken.

SAFE AND SUPPORTIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

BIKE SAFETY

We remind children who ride bikes and scooters to school to ensure that they are properly stored. For scooters they need to be placed in the block where your child's class is– or they should be secured to the bike rack. For bikes, these need to be locked at the bike racks. There have been several reported cases of strangers at the bike rack during school hours. On inspection, several bikes are not locked and the school is very limited in the action that can be taken if this is the case. We have relocated bike racks to shady more secure areas in Millstream and Karijini.
