Principals Update

Learning

High Quality Teaching

PATS assessment in reading and mathematics have just been completed and we will be able to see how students have progressed since term 4 last year. This is important for parents and students to see how they went, please see your child's teacher for their results in reading and mathematics.

In 'On Entry' over all our students in Year 1 were above the national state mean in all three areas of numeracy, reading and writing. The PP students were equal to other like schools in all three areas. Congratulations to our early childhood teachers in the last couple of years for their great teaching in mathematics and english.

School Improvement

Next year we are leading into our 'Public School Review' and feedback from our last review was to track our students who have been with us since PP. We recently shared this data at the School Development Day, to ensure that we were delivering effective programmes and that our students were progressing. We are also collating and tracking our students progress on the 'MultiTiered System of Support' Document and this information can clearly identify who needs additional supports, who is achieving and who isn't.



Principal Performance Review

The Principal Performance Review team will be visiting to see how the school has been operating and meet with myself for three hours for my performance review. I have created a leadership plan after reviewing the data and the feedback from over 27 surveys from staff and parents. I will share the recommendations of this review at the next couple of meetings with staff and parents.

Reporting

The Department of Education has made significant changes to information included in school reports from pre-primary to year 10. This is a workload reduction strategy and to support consistency across schools. The changes are that only English, Maths and EAL/D will have a grade allocated to the sub strands, all other areas will be allocated a grade only. There will be an overall comment which will be approximately 1000 characters.

We will also be having a 'Reporting to Parents' interview day on Tuesday 25 August, where parents can schedule time to meet with parents, there will be more information on this closer to the day. This is a day that the school will not have students at school for the normal school day. If there are any issues with this, please ring the school to discuss with myself. This is in the final planning phase and the same across the Karratha Network Schools.
